L. Solstice is a new collection of printed scarves marrying traditional print processes with a contemporary aesthetic. The limited edition collection by Yemi Awosile combines quality natural materials with striking patterns using natural dye block print and Indigo mud resist.

Launched at 100% Design South Africa the Soldier Stool is a collaboration between South African design studio Dokter and Misses and expert weavers Gone Rural, Swaziland. The stool features a grass seat, handwoven using a combination of sustainably harvested sisal and indigenous Lutindzi grass, which grows wild on rocky outcrops in the Swazi mountains, and is available in various colourways: and in either solid or astro woven finishes, which is achieved by combining two contrasting colours. Stackable coated steel frames make it suitable for outdoors.

The Myelo Desk by South AFrican furniture design Siyanda Mbele is an exploration of modern working life, referecning the way people spend long hours at their desks. The Birth Chair II is inspired by Africa's woodcarving heritage and is given a contemporary update by Ethiopian/American furniture designer Jomo Tariku.



The CARAT LED Pendant lamps are latest offering from Finnish-Ugandan designer KAYIWA. Specialing in collectible customizable design the diamond-faceted pendant is formed from hand-blown glass that is sandblasted and brushed with pumice, creating an extraordinary texture that diffuses the light into a soft glow
